



## PREFACE

The preparation of a Comprehensive Land use Plan is basically founded on the analysis of the development problems of an area and the vision of its people. The preparation of the CLUP of the Municipality of Orion, Bataan starts with the compilation of data from the five development sectors for a comprehensive analysis of its problems, potentials and constraints.

The preparation of an ecological profile independent from the preparation of the CLUP is an approach that will help future planners of the municipality in analyzing the stretch of progress achieved through the years.



This Ecological Profile of the Municipality of Orion serves as a source of baseline data for the five development sectors: social sector, economic sector, environmental management sector, infrastructure and utilities sector and the institutional and administration sector.

The document contains data gathered through the different agencies and offices and in the case of the economic sector through the conduct of surveys at the barangay level. The survey was conducted to update and validate the authenticity of certain data presented and used in previous plans made by the municipal government.

No analysis is made and presented in the profile but the document aims to serve as reference on the current state of the whole municipality on the time of its preparation.

The Ecological Profile is the output of the Technical Working Groups (TWG) organized by the Municipal Government in the preparation of the CLUP. The TWGs worked hard in the gathering and organizing of the data through the facilitation and guidance of the University of the Philippines School of Urban and Regional Planning (UPSURP) Team.
